<p>1. Purpose Title 22 Sec. 14.102, 14.104, 339.21, 339.22</p>	<p>Every student with a disability attending Middle Bucks Institute of Technology shall be offered an educational program and services that meet the student’s needs for educational, instructional, transitional and related services. Such a program shall be designed to comply with law and shall conform to the goals of the school. Integration of students into the regular instructional program of the school shall be a guiding principle.</p>
<p>2. Definition Title 22 Sec. 14.101 34 CFR Sec. 300.8</p>	<p>Students with disabilities - school-aged children who have been evaluated and found to have one or more disabilities as defined by applicable state and federal laws and regulations, and who require, because of such disabilities, special education and related services.</p>
<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>The Administrative Director shall recommend annually to the Executive Council the employment and retention of necessary, qualified staff, and the provision of required facilities, programs, and services to provide for the needs of students with disabilities.</p> <p>The Director shall develop procedures for the continuing evaluation of the effectiveness of the school’s special education plan and shall periodically report to the Executive Council the criteria by which such evaluations are made and the results of such evaluation.</p> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
