	113. SPECIAL EDUCATION
1.Purpose SC 1371	Every student with a disability attending the Vocational-Technical School shall be offered an educational program that meets his/her individual needs and is suited to his/her unique abilities. Such a program shall be designed to comply with law and shall conform to the goals of the school. Integration of students into the regular instructional program of the school shall be a guiding principle.
2.Definition	Students with disabilities to be served by the educational program of this school shall include those school age children as defined by law who reside in a participating school district(s) for whom a vocational-technical program is considered a "least restrictive" environment.
3.Responsibility	The Director shall recommend annually to the Executive Council the employment and retention of staff, and the provision of programs, as may be necessary and feasible to provide for the needs of exceptional children of the school.
Title 22 Sec. 13.11	The program to which each exceptional child is assigned shall be that which best assures his/her success in learning and offers him/her the least restrictive environment in accordance with State regulations.
	The Director shall develop procedures for the continuing evaluation of the effectiveness of the school's plan for the exceptional pupil and shall periodically report to the Executive Council the criteria by which such evaluations are made and the results of such evaluation.
