202. ELIGIBILITY OF NONRESIDENT STUDENTS	
<p>1. Purpose SC 1807, 1841</p> <p>SC 1809, 1847, 1850.1</p>	<p>The Executive Council shall operate the School for the benefit of students' resident in the four (4) participating school districts and eligible for attendance.</p> <p>The Executive Council may permit the admission of nonresident students in accordance with terms of this policy.</p>
<p>2. Authority SC 1302</p> <p>SC 1847</p>	<p>The Executive Council reserves the right to verify the residency of any student and to require a sworn statement of residential support for the student who resides with a person other than his/her parent/guardian or custodian.</p> <p>Whenever the Professional Advisory Council finds that additional students may be enrolled and all of the students from participating school districts have been accommodated, tuition students may be enrolled.</p>
<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility</p> <p>SC 1850</p>	<p>The Director or designee shall develop procedures for the enrollment of nonresident students which:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Admit such student only on the proper application of the parent/guardian. 2. Do not exclude any student, otherwise eligible, on the basis of such student's race, color, religion, national origin, disability, sex, or limited English proficiency. 3. Make continued enrollment of any nonresident student contingent upon maintaining good standards of citizenship and discipline. <p>Tuition rates shall be determined in accordance with applicable provisions of the School Code.</p>
