215. PROMOTION AND RETENTION	
<p>1. Purpose</p>	<p>The Executive Council recognizes that the emotional, social, physical and educational growth of students will vary and that students should be placed in the educational setting most appropriate to their needs at the various stages of their growth.</p>
<p>2. Authority SC 1531 Title 22 Sec. 4.42 Pol. 213</p>	<p>It is the policy of the Executive Council that each student shall be moved forward in a continuous pattern of achievement and growth that corresponds with his/her own development and the system of levels and technical skill standards established for each level.</p> <p>A student shall be promoted when s/he has successfully achieved the technical skill standards established for the present level, based on the professional judgment of his/her teachers and the results of assessment.</p>
<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility Title 22 Sec. 4.12, 4.13 Pol. 100 Pol. 213</p>	<p>The Director or designee shall develop procedures for promotion and retention of students, which assure that every effort will be made to remediate the student's difficulties before s/he is retained.</p> <p>The recommendation of the classroom teacher shall be required for promotion or retention of a student.</p> <p>Parents/Guardians shall be informed well in advance of the possibility of retention of a student.</p> <p>The Assistant Director shall be assigned the final responsibility for determining the promotion or retention of each student.</p>
