224. CARE OF SCHOOL PROPERTY	
1.Purpose	The Executive Council believes that the school should help students learn to respect property and develop feelings of pride in community institutions.
2.Authority	The Executive Council charges each student in the school with responsibility for the proper care of school property and the school supplies and equipment entrusted to his/her use.
SC 777	<p>Students who willfully cause damage to school property shall be subject to disciplinary measures. Students and others who damage or deface school property may be prosecuted and punished under law. Parents and guardians of students shall be held accountable for student actions.</p> <p>The Executive Council may report to the appropriate juvenile authorities any student whose damage of school property has been serious or chronic in nature.</p>
3.Delegation of Responsibility	The Director or a designee shall develop procedures to implement this policy which include:
SC 801	<p>rules for the safekeeping and accounting of textbooks, supplies and equipment.</p> <p>preparation of a schedule of fines for lost or damaged textbooks, supplies and equipment.</p> <p>a report to the Executive Council on the incidence of vandalism, including the number and kind of incident, the cost of vandalism to the school, and other related facts and comments.</p>
