TITLE: STUDENTS AND THE POLICE

1.Purpose

The Executive Council recognizes that compulsory attendance laws impose on it the custodianship of the students while they are present in the school.

2. Authority

When police request permission to interrogate a student at school, the Director or a designee shall make every attempt to inform the student's parents.

Whenever the Director or a designee has determined that the police have a legitimate purpose in interrogating a student within the confines of the school, an administrator shall be present throughout the proceedings.

When the police request permission to arrest a student at school, the Director or a designee shall make every attempt to inform the student's parents and request and inspect the arrest warrant.

No student shall be released to police authorities without proper warrant, appropriate evidence or written parental permission, except in the event of emergency or for the protection of life or property as determined by the administrator.
