	230. PUBLIC PERFORMANCES BY STUDENTS
1.Purpose	The Executive Council recognizes the value to students of sharing their talents and skills with the community through student participation and performances in public events.
2.Authority	The Executive Council endorses such performances when they constitute a learning experience which contributes to the educational program; they do not interfere with other scheduled activities of the school; and the circumstances of the event do not pose a threat to the health, safety and well-being of the students who will be involved.
	All requests for public performances by student groups require the approval of the Executive Council.
3.Delegation of Responsibility	The Director or a designee shall develop proce dures to implement this policy which require that: parental permission is sought and received before students may participate.  no student is compelled to participate in a public performance or penalized in any way for failure to do so.  no student, group of students or employes of the school may receive compensation for the performance in public of students organized as a school representative.  the interests of students are protected and guarded against exploitation.
