230. PUBLIC PERFORMANCES BY STUDENTS	
1.Purpose	<p>The Executive Council recognizes the value to students of sharing their talents and skills with the community through student participation and performances in public events.</p>
2.Authority	<p>The Executive Council endorses such performances when they constitute a learning experience which contributes to the educational program; they do not interfere with other scheduled activities of the school; and the circumstances of the event do not pose a threat to the health, safety and well-being of the students who will be involved.</p> <p>All requests for public performances by student groups require the approval of the Executive Council.</p>
3.Delegation of Responsibility	<p>The Director or a designee shall develop procedures to implement this policy which require that: parental permission is sought and received before students may participate.</p> <p>no student is compelled to participate in a public performance or penalized in any way for failure to do so.</p> <p>no student, group of students or employees of the school may receive compensation for the performance in public of students organized as a school representative.</p> <p>the interests of students are protected and guarded against exploitation.</p>
