	416. NONTENURED STAFF MEMBERS
1.Purpose	It is the policy of the Executive Council that certain staff members be employed with the recognition that the function to be performed does not fall under the control of the tenure law.
2.Authority	The Executive Council may elect to have certain functions performed by professional employes despite the fact that such functions are not controlled by certification and tenure law. When this occurs, such actions shall be deemed to be discretionary actions by the Executive Council without intent to have such functions considered as professional employe actions governed by tenure.
SC 111	No candidate shall be employed until such candidate has complied with the mandatory background check requirements for criminal history and the administration has evaluated the results of that screening process.
