	419. OUTSIDE ACTIVITIES
1.Purpose	The Executive Council recognizes that members of the staff must enjoy private lives and may associate with others outside of school for political, economic, religious, cultural or personal reasons. However, the Executive Council and its supervisory staff have a responsibility to evaluate staff members in terms of their faithfulness to, and effectiveness in discharging school duties and responsibilities. Therefore, when nonschool activities threaten a staff member's effectiveness within the school system, the Executive Council reserves the right to evaluate the impact of such activities upon a professional employe's responsibilities to the students and to the school's programs.
