425. DRESS AND GROOMING	
1.Purpose	Teachers set an example in dress and grooming for their students to follow. A teacher should present an image of dignity and encourage respect for authority. These factors act in a positive manner towards the maintenance of classroom discipline.
2.Authority SC 510	<p>The Executive Council has the authority to specify reasonable dress and grooming guidelines for staff, within law, that will prevent such matters from having an adverse impact on the educational process. All staff members, when assigned to duty, shall be physically clean, neat, well groomed and dressed in a manner reflecting professional assignment.</p> <p>If a teacher feels that an exception to this policy because of special circumstances would enable him/her to carry out assigned duties more effectively, a request should be made to the Director.</p>
