	814. COPYRIGHT MATERIAL
1.Purpose P.L.94-553 Sec. 107	The Executive Council recognizes that the United States Code makes it illegal for anyone to duplicate copyrighted materials without permission. The Executive Council further realizes that severe penalties are provided for unauthorized copying of audio, visual, or printed materials unless the copying falls within the bounds of the "fair use" doctrine.
2.Definition	Under the fair use doctrine, unauthorized reproduction of copyrighted materials is permissible for such purposes as criticism, comment, news reporting, teaching, scholarship or research.
3.Responsibility Pol. 814-R	Staff may make copies of copyrighted school materials that fall within guidelines established by the Executive Council. Where there is reason to believe the material to be copied does not fall within these guidelines, prior permission shall be obtained from the Director. Staff members who fail to follow this policy may be held personally liable for copyright infringement.
