	903. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION IN EXECUTIVE COUNCIL MEETINGS
1.Purpose 65 P.S. 271 et seq	The Executive Council recognizes the value to school governance of public comment on educational issues and the importance of involving members of the public in meetings of the Executive Council.
2.Authority	In order to permit fair and orderly expression of such comment, the Executive Council will provide a period for public participation at every open meeting of the Executive Council and will formulate rules to govern such public participation in Board meetings.
3.Delegation of Responsibility	The presiding officer at each public Executive Council meeting will follow the rules for conduct of public meetings in accordance with this policy and Policy 006.
4.Guidelines 65 P.S. 271 et seq Pol. 006	The presiding officer shall be guided by the following rules: Public participation shall be permitted only as indicated on the order of business in the Procedures of the Executive Council. Particpants must be recognized by the presiding officer and must preface their comments by an announcement of their name and group affiliation, if appropriate. Smoking is prohibited during meetings of the Executive Council at the Middle Bucks Institute of Technology.
