	905. CITIZEN ADVISORY COMMITTEES
1.Purpose	Citizen advisory committees are sometimes useful in keeping the Executive Council and administration informed with regard to community opinion and in representing the community in the study of specific school problems.
2.Regulations	In creating a new advisory committee, the Executive Council shall define the committee assignment and shall appoint residents who are interested and can make some special contribution to the committee's function.
	In charging a new advisory committee, the Executive Council shall set a date for a preliminary and final report.
	Recommendations of all advisory committees shall not reduce the responsibility of the Executive Council, which shall be free to accept or reject the recommendations as it sees fit. Meetings of an advisory committee are not regular meetings of the Executive Council and shall not be open to the public.
