Tuition-Free for students in district

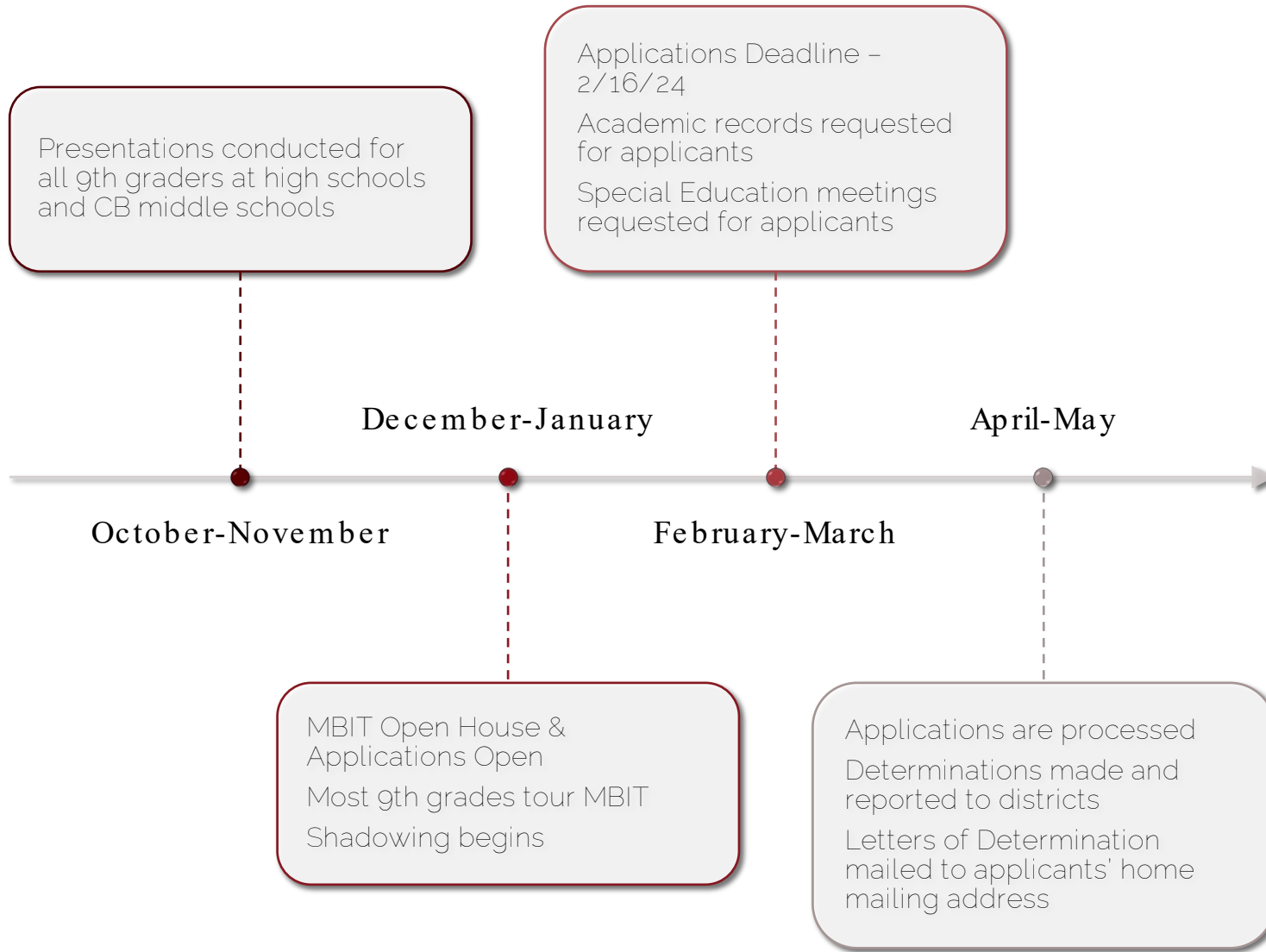
Fees in all programs to cover tools, materials, and certifications



Transportation

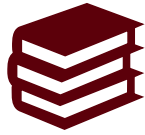
Busses provided by the school district
