In addition to agreements between MBIT and the post-secondary schools, agreements have been initiated state-wide through the Pennsylvania Department of Education SOAR (Students Occupationally and Academically Ready) Initiative. These agreements can be found online at www.collegetransfer.net and by searching *PA Bureau of CTE SOAR Programs*.

Students are also eligible for *four (4) college credits* through the National College Credit Recommendation Service based on their NOCTI written score. Students must receive at least a 70% on the written component of the *Culinary Arts Level 2 Cook* NOCTI Post-Test to receive college credit.
