- LAES3147 – Today’s Sustainable Homestead. This course satisfies requirements in Floriculture, Environmental Design and Landscape Contracting (3 credits)
- HT1101 – Exploring Horticulture, Science and the Environment. This course satisfies requirements in Commercial Crop Production, Marketing, Hydroponic Crop Science, Plant Science and Biotechnology (2 credits)

New and updated agreements will be added to this document on an on-going basis.

In addition to agreements between MBIT and the post-secondary schools, agreements have been initiated state-wide through the Pennsylvania Department of Education SOAR (Students Occupationally and Academically Ready) Initiative. These agreements can be found online at www.collegetransfer.net and by searching *PA Bureau of CTE SOAR Programs*.

Students are also eligible for *three (3) college credits* through the National College Credit Recommendation Service based on their NOCTI written score. Students must receive at least a 70% on the written component of the *Horticulture – Landscaping* NOCTI Post-Test to receive college credit.
