#### **Bucks County Community College:**

- BIOL115 – Basic Human Anatomy (3 credits); contingent upon current EMT certification
- CRIJ260 – Probation and Parole (3 credits)
- CRIJ275 – Introduction to Correctional Administration (3 credits)
- FRSC100 – Introduction to Fire Science (3 credits); contingent upon IFSAC or Pro-Board certification for Fire Fighter I
- FRSC112 – Fire Behavior and Combustion (3 credits)
- FRSC114- Principles of Fire and Emergency Services Safety & Security (3 credits)
- HLTH110 – Responding to Emergencies (3 credits); contingent upon current AED, CPR and EMT/First Aid certification

Equivalent credit awards are contingent upon courses fulfilling program requirements.

- BEM101 – Introduction to Emergency Management Operations (3 credits)

New and updated agreements will be added to this document on an on-going basis.

In addition to agreements between MBIT and the post-secondary schools, agreements have been initiated state-wide through the Pennsylvania Department of Education SOAR (Students Occupationally and Academically Ready) Initiative. These agreements can be found online at [www.collegetransfer.net](http://www.collegetransfer.net) and by searching *PA Bureau of CTE SOAR Programs*.

Students are also eligible for *three (3) college credits* through the National College Credit Recommendation Service based on their NOCTI written score. Students must receive at least a 70% on the written component of the *Criminal Justice* NOCTI Post-Test to receive college credit.
