- alignment between challenging academic standards and relevant career and technical content





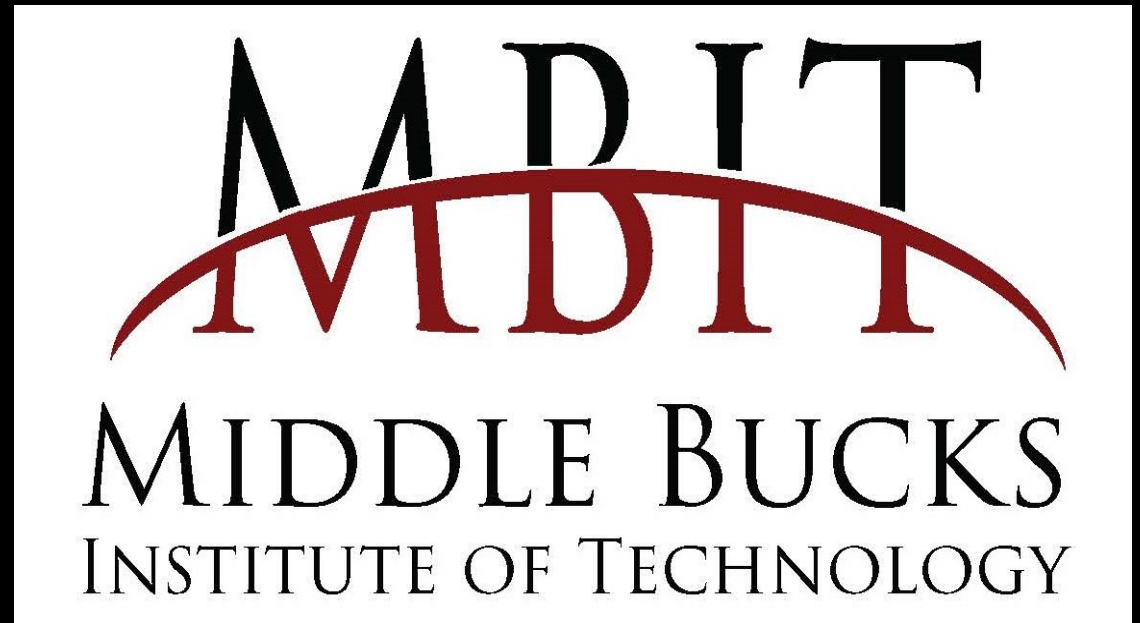
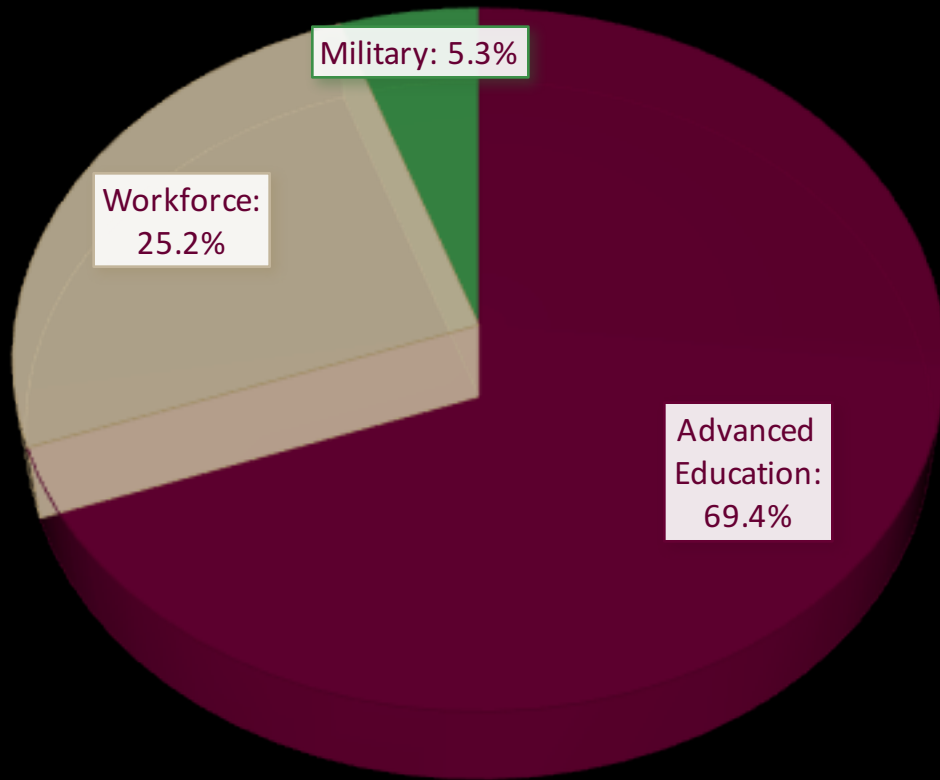
