RE: Urine Drug Testing

In order for a student to participate in the Clinical experience, all of the clinical sites that have a relationship with Middle Bucks Institute of Technology require a mandatory urine drug test. If the test is not conducted or is not satisfactory, the student will not be participating in the Clinical experience.

What this means:

- 1- The students must have a urine drug test.
- 2- A paper, from the lab or doctor’s office showing the date of the test must be turned in. See Note above for due date.
- 3- Once you have the results, an original copy of that must be brought into school or be faxed to 215-491-2697.
- 4- Failure to hand in the paperwork on time or pass the test will eliminate your son/daughter from any clinical experiences for the entire school year.
- 5- Depending on your insurance, you will need to call your family doctor for a referral to go to LabCorp or Quest labs. Grand View Workplace Health offers the testing for \$57. No insurance accepted. Contact them at 215-453-4941 to schedule.
